Zoo Boise Use Policies

Accessibility

- Private events at Zoo Boise are from 5:30 9:00PM in the summer season. End times are adjusted according to sunset times in the shoulder seasons. Please refer Rental Cost for dates. All clean up and exit of guests is required by event end time.
- Early entrance for set up or decorating must be arranged in advance through the Zoo Boise Events Manager. A limit of five people are allowed for early entrance. People and supplies must be gathered and enter at one time. Renter shall supply transport of all items. Zoo staff and equipment are not available for use. Delivery of items prior to event day must be confirmed with Zoo Boise Events Manager and may not happen before 4:00PM one day in advance. Early entrance for photos is limited to wedding party and photographer staff. Friends and extended family members must wait for event start time.
- Zoo Boise event facilities are shown by appointment only. If you would like to schedule a facility tour, or need further information, contact the Events Manager at (208) 608-7744 or <u>e-mail</u>.
- Tables and chairs to accommodate approximately 120 guests are available for use in Conservation Plaza. These are included in the basic rental fee. For weddings, up to four tables may be used at no additional cost if needed for cake, gifts, guest book, and DJ. These must be reserved through the Zoo Boise Events and Client Relations Manager in advance. If additional items are needed, or used in another portion of the zoo, a rental/service fee will apply.
- Parking is a first come first serve basis within Julia Davis Park and cannot be reserved for guests.

Amplified Sound

- Amplified sound is available at no additional cost. We have three systems available: all zoo,
 Conservation Plaza, and Gorongosa National Park Exhibit.
- Sound levels are at the discretion of zoo staff and shall not in any way disturb animals.
- Renter shall supply any and all devices needed to play music.
- Sound permits are available through Boise Parks & Recreation at https://www.cityofboise.org/departments/parks-and-recreation and ensure priority within Julia Davis Park.
- DJs and live music are permitted. They must adhere to all sound level restrictions and must coordinate with the Zoo Boise Events and Client Relations Manager for zoo entrance and set up.

Food and Alcohol

- All food and alcohol, including water and snacks, served at a private event must be arranged through Zoo Boise's preferred caterer, Taste Catering. The catering department can be reached at (720) 841-0229 or by <u>e-mail</u>. No outside food or caterers are permitted onsite with the exception of wedding cakes.
- Individuals under 21 years of age will not be allowed to consume or possess any alcohol.
- Zoo Boise and Taste Catering reserves rights to "cut off" alcohol consumption at any time if deemed necessary.
- All beer and alcohol is to remain within the gates of Zoo Boise.
- All alcohol distribution will end 30 minutes prior to end of event.

Zoo Boise Use Policies (continued)

Decorations and Promotional Materials

- No balloons are allowed on zoo grounds. This includes arches and bouquets.
- Sparklers or open flame decorations are not allowed. All candles must be battery operated.
- All decorations must be in public spaces. No items may be attached to animal exhibits or behind fencing.
- Hanging items from any fire sprinkler or light fixture is strictly prohibited.
- Confetti, rice, and artificial flower pedals are prohibited.
- Using tape, tacks, nails, or staples must be approved in advance by Zoo Boise's Event Manager.
- All items must be removed by event end time. Any items not taken at end of event will not be the responsibility of Zoo Boise.

Facility and Grounds

- Alteration of zoo property is prohibited. Facility is accepted in its "as is" condition.
- All outside animals with the exception of service animals are prohibited onsite. Emotional support or comfort animals are not permitted.
- Smoking and vaping are prohibited on zoo property.
- Vehicles may be pulled to gate for offloading but may not be driven inside the zoo.

Deposits, Refunds, and Cancellations

- 50% non-refundable deposit is required within two weeks of contract/invoice date. Balance is due one week prior to event date.
- Cancellations must be submitted in writing to the Zoo Boise Events and Client Relations Manager.
- Refunds will be issued, less the 50% non-refundable deposit, by check within 14 days of cancellation notice.
- Inclement weather conditions do not warrant cancellation or refunds.
- Zoo Boise may cancel event at any time if City of Boise mandates prohibit public gatherings due
 to pandemics, weather, air quality or any other occurrences deemed unsafe. If rescheduling is
 not an option, full refunds will be issued.

Additional Wedding Access

- The Zoo Boise Wedding Package includes extended rental time, private bridal tent, and cheese board with champagne or sparkling cider (if catering is included). In the wedding package, Zoo Boise is available from 5:30 10:00PM in the summer season. Guests will have access to the whole zoo during summer season. If booking during shoulder seasons, guests have access to all of the zoo until sunset and will then be required to stay in the Conservation Plaza until event end time. Bookings during the winter season have access to Gorongosa National Park Exhibit only. Refer to Rental Cost for dates. All clean up and exit of guests is required by event end time.
- Zoo Boise has several beautiful and intimate places to hold your ceremony and take photographs.
 By scheduling a facility tour, our staff can point out favorite photo spots for you to choose.
 Receptions in the summer and shoulder seasons must be held in Conservation Plaza.
